Surf Life Saving Queensland provides guidelines on the contents of first aid kits and first aid rooms. Guidance is also provided through workplace advisory standard on First Aid.

Additional first aid equipment advisable for stinger prone regions include:

Sub-tropical Coastal Regions (Agnes Water to Yeppoon)

- Vinegar (minimum 5 litres)
- Ice packs/ice
- Oxygen equipment
- Defibrillator

Tropical Coastal Regions (north of Yeppoon)

- Vinegar (minimum 10 litres)
- Ice packs/ice
- Oxygen equipment
- Defibrillator

Marine stinger drag kit

The contents of a marine stinger drag kit are as follows:

- copy of Marine Stinger Risk Management Guidelines
- copy of Incident Report Flow Chart
- copy of contact phone numbers applicable to that area
- Marine Stinger Netting Log
- pen, pencil and notebook
- tide chart
- stinger suits (full body length one-piece lycra or neoprene) – 2x medium, 2x large, 2x extra large
- booties – 2x medium, 2x large
- disposable gloves – 1 box
- heavy duty gloves – 4 pairs
- gaffa tape – 3 rolls
- specimen jars x20
- collection bowl x1
- masking tape and nikko pen
- broadbrim hat x2
- polarised sunglasses x2
- plastic sealable bags x20
- Formalin (1L) and instruction guide – for authorised and trained personnel only
- bucket – 1x 20L minimum
- atomiser spray bottle x1 – for washing suits with vinegar
- 20L of vinegar
- 1x drag net – 30m minimum (must be specially made and DPI permission sourced).
